



# Knitting 101 - 2 sticks not a hook

Have you always wondered about individuals that were just going to town creating with yarn and two pointed (2) sticks (Knitting needles)? Join fiber artist Anne Bird, she will guide you on the basics of knitting. After practicing, you will be able to begin creating your own knitted items. Start with a scarf or a hat that is knitted flat and then stitched together. No knitting experience necessary.

## You will learn:

- knitting terminology
- CO - cast on stitches
- knit stitch
- garter stitch
- purl stitch
- stockinette stitch
- BO – bind off stitches

- pair of knitting needles
- wool yarn to practice with
- tapestry needle
- 1 skein of wool to begin your knitting journey
